TASTING NOTES

This wine is garnet in color and offers a dark fruit nose of blueberry, blackberry, licorice and caramel. The palate flavors move to red with candied cherry, red currant and toasted bread. Good tension, concentration and refined tannins make this wine very enjoyable all the way through its long finish. This balanced wine will age gracefully for 7 to 10 years.
