TASTING NOTES

This ruby colored Pinot Noir offers cranberry, Rainier cherry and rose petal aromas. Red cherry, dried sage, red currant and smoke flavors are found on the palate. The mouthfeel is smooth and round. There is a sweet approach with good acidity in the finish and well-integrated tannins. This wine is delicious today and will continue to improve through 2022.
