Garnet-ruby in color with aromas of raspberry, cherry toast, strawberry and green apple. Juicy flavors of spicy cherry and red berry mimic the nose with a touch of sweetness at the finish. This graceful wine shows a refreshing entry with smooth tannins and balanced acidity. The 2011 Kiana Pinot Noir will age well for 7-8 years.
