TASTING NOTES

Eggplant in color, the 2011 Terres Basses Pinot Noir shows off handsome aromas of forest floor, cassis, spice and orange peel. The mouthfeel is lush with pepper, oolong tea, licorice and herbal notes on the palate. Extremely well-balanced and structured, good acidity and concentration from beginning to end. This wine will age well for 10+ years.
